# CROCHET SCARF · SILKHAIR

## Design 15 – natural KNITS 01



**Size** approx. 192 x 55 cm

**Materials:** 125 g of Lana Grossa **Silkhair** (70% superkid mohair, 30% silk; 210 m/25 g) in Powder Pink (col 86). Size 4 mm crochet hook.


**Main patt:** Multiple of 10 + 1 + 4 (counts as tr). Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Work first 3 tr on first row in 6th ch from hook. Work to patt rep, work sts between arrows for patt rep, work to end of chart. Work rows 1 – 4 once, then rep rows 3 and 4.

**Gauge:** 2 patt reps and 5 rows = 8.5 x 10 cm with size 4 mm hook. **Note:** Main patt is crocheted loosely.

**Scarf:** Worked in 2 halves from the center out. Arrows on schematic show direction of work. Ch 131 + ch 4. Work chart for 47 rows and piece meas approx. 96 cm, ending with a chart row 3. Fasten off. Rotate piece 180 degrees clockwise and crochet in bottom loops of foundation row: Sl st-join in first ch of foundation row. Beg with chart row 1 (begins with ch 4), work chart for 47 rows and piece meas approx. 96 cm, ending with a chart row 3. Fasten off.

**Finishing:** Pin piece to measurements and block, taking care to pinning out each scallop individually. Carefully weave in all ends.

**Chart key:**


- = chain (ch)

- ⋮⋮⋮•⋮⋮⋮ = [3 tr, ch 1, 1 tr, ch 1, 3 tr] in same st and/or sp

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

## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
